(PERMITTED PARKING AREA AND SPECIAL PARKING AREA)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING)
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2003 (VARIATION) ORDER 2008
[PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON ALBANY ROAD AND VICAR STREET,
WORCESTER]**

On 22 May 2008 Worcestershire County Council made the following Order which will prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of roads in **Worcester**:

Albany Road	from its junction with Vicar Street for a distance of 8 metres
(west side)	in a northerly direction.
(east side)	from its junction with Vicar Street for a distance of 9 metres in a northerly direction.
VICAR STREET	from its junction with Albany Road for a distance of 9 metres in a south-easterly direction.
(north side)	

The Order will vary the above Consolidation Order (which provides for decriminalised enforcement of contraventions of waiting prohibitions and restrictions) and will contain exemptions to allow parking/access for certain purposes and limited waiting by disabled persons vehicles.

The Order will come into operation on 4 June 2008.

A copy of the Order, relevant map and Statement of Reasons for making the Order may be inspected at Worcester Customer Service Centre, Orchard House, Farrier Street, Worcester, WR1 3BB and County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, WR5 2NP during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 10 July 2008.
