

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OLD BIRMINGHAM ROAD AND COTTAGE LANE, MARLBROOK, BROMSGROVE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2008

On 28 May 2008 Worcestershire County Council made an Order with modifications. The effect of these modifications will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of roads in Marlbrook:

### **Old Birmingham Road**

(north side)

from its junction with Cottage Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a south westerly direction; and

from its junction with Cottage Drive/Cottage Lane for a distance of 16.5 metres in a southerly then north easterly direction.

(south side)

from a point 15 metres northeast of its junction with Linehouse Lane for a distance of 36 metres in a north-easterly direction.

### **Cottage Lane**

(west side)

from its junction with Old Birmingham Road for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction; and

(east side)

from its junction with Cottage Drive for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction.

The Order will come into operation on 5 June 2008.

The Order will contain exemptions to allow parking/access for certain purposes and limited waiting by disabled persons vehicles.

A copy of the Order, relevant map and Statement of Reasons for making the Order may be inspected at Bromsgrove District Council, Burcot Lane, Bromsgrove B60 1AA and County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, WR5 2NP during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 9 July 2008.
