(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES)
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2007 (VARIATION) ORDER 2008

[PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON WINDERMERE WAY AND DERWENT AVENUE, STOURPORT]

On 22 May 2008 Worcestershire County Council made the following Order which will **prohibit waiting at any time** on the following lengths of road in **Stourport**:

Windermere Way (south side) from its junction with Derwent Avenue for a distance of 13 metres in an easterly direction, and 13 metres in a westerly direction.

Derwent Avenue (both sides) from its junction with Windermere Way for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

The Order will vary the above Consolidation Order (which provides for decriminalised enforcement of contraventions of waiting prohibitions and restrictions) and will contain exemptions to allow parking/access for certain purposes and limited waiting by disabled persons vehicles.

The Order will come into operation on 10 June 2008.

A copy of the Order, relevant map and Statement of Reasons for making the Order may be inspected at Wyre Forest District Council, Civic Centre, Stourport, DY13 8UJ, and County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, WR5 2NP during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 17 July 2008.
