The Worcestershire TaMHS Pathfinder Project

- The Worcestershire TaMHS (Targeted Mental Health Services for Schools) Pathfinder Project is a DCSF funded initiative aimed at improving mental health outcomes for children and young people via interventions delivered through schools.
- The TaMHS Pathfinder Project is concerned with the development of innovative therapeutic and holistic mental health support in schools aimed at children and young people between the age of 5 years and 13 years and their families.
- The long term aim is to integrate effective early intervention models with assessment, referral and intervention work within Targeted Support Services and Specialist CAMHS.
- TaMHS will be delivered to 3 school clusters located in the Wyre Forest, Redditch and Malvern.
- The TaMHS Pathfinder Project is funded for 2 years from April 2009.
